Rules:

- Teams will consist of 4 players.
- Players with USGA course handicaps of 9 and below from the back tees (8.1 USGA HCP INDEX) must play the **Green Tees**. USGA course handicaps of 10 & above from the back tees (8.2 USGA HCP INDEX) play from the **White Tees**. Players **50** and over may play the **White Tees**, and Players **65** & over may play the **Gold Tees** regardless of handicap. Ladies will play the forward, **Red Tees**.
- All players hit TEE SHOTS, select best ball and play next shot from that spot, **within one club length**, no nearer the hole.
- You may move your ball, but **must stay in the same cut** of grass. If you're in the rough, you must stay in the rough. If off the green, you must position your ball within the club length, not nearer the hole and still remain off of the green.
- Should you be forced to select a ball in a bunker, **the person who hit into the bunker must play from the existing lie first**, then remaining team members may place their balls in the bunker for their shots.

CALCUTTA EVENT

Men's Golf Assoc. – Player of the Year Event

Format:

This two day event is made up of **Three Man Teams**, playing a **combination of scramble and low ball** formats.

All players will hit tee shots, and choose the best drive to play for their second shot. Each player then plays his own ball until holed out. After completing the hole, the **two individual lowest scores combined** will be the team score and should be recorded in the Team Total Score box. Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each flight, Keg on the course, **Long Drive & Closest to the pin** awards

Teams will be pre-flighted by the Golf Professionals.

Tee Buster: Each player may choose to purchase a Tee Buster. This entitles each player the opportunity to **hit from a ladies tee 1 time each day**. The cost is \$10.00 for both days.

A winner and runner up from each flight will advance to the Final Shootout to determine the overall winner of the Chicago Four Ball event.

Rules:

- After the team chooses a Tee Shot, all U.S.G.A. rules will govern play except where amended by local rules..
- Players with USGA course handicaps of 9 and below from the back tees (8.1 USGA HCP INDEX) must play the **Green Tees**. USGA course handicaps of 10 & above from the back tees (8.2 USGA HCP INDEX) play from the **White Tees**. Players **50** and over may play the **White Tees**, and Players **65** & over may play the **Gold Tees** regardless of handicap.
- **Teams will be flighted** by their combined team handicap. Each team will **receive _ of their handicap for flighting purposes** and shoot out only.
- Play own ball, down, through the green and hole out.
- If determined to be out of the hole, **you may pick up, but partners MUST finish the hole.**
- The Team Score will be the **Best Ball total of the two lowest scores.**
- All play will be governed by Summer Rules, or as it lies (Down) except as otherwise provided by the Rules of Golf.
- 14 club and one ball rule apply.
- Due to the Calcutta no juniors allowed

Men's Golf Assoc. – Player of the Year Event

Format: This Tournament is shaped around the playing challenges of The NCAA Basketball Tournament. Sixty-four players qualify for the Match Play Event. Match winners proceed to the next round of 32, to Sweet Sixteen, Elite Eight, the Final Four and ultimately the Championship Match.

Qualifying:

- You **MUST** have a current **U.S.G.A. Handicap**.
- A **Qualifying round** of stroke play will be played and **attested to** by another golfer who is also playing in the event.
- **This score will determine your seeding** in the Tournament Brackets.
- **Only the 64 Low Score Players will Qualify** for the Match Play brackets.

Tees:

- Players with USGA course handicaps of 9 and below from the back tees (8.1 USGA HCP INDEX) must play the **Green Tees**. USGA course handicaps of 10 & above from the back tees (8.2 USGA HCP INDEX) play from the **White Tees**. Players **50** and over may play the **White Tees**, and Players **65** & over may play the **Gold Tees** regardless of handicap.

The Matches:

- All matches will be played **with** handicap and **score cards must be authenticated and verified for handicaps by Memphis National Golf Professional BEFORE play begins.**
- Matches will be played in a timely manner (2 weeks) or the Tournament Committee & Golf Professionals will determine who progresses in the bracket. Determination may be by competitor concession, coin toss, or disqualification.
- We will **COMPLETE THE MATCHES IN EIGHT WEEKS** (weather permitting).

CALCUTTA EVENT
Men's Golf Assoc. – Player of the Year Event**

Format:

This event consists of two man teams with each person playing his own ball. The lower of the partners' scores is the score for the hole. This is a handicapped event and you will need a current U.S.G.A. Handicap to participate. ! Awards to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each flight, Keg on the course, **Long Drive & Closest to the pin awards**

Rules:

- All U.S.G.A. rules will govern play except where amended by local rules..
- Players with USGA course handicaps of 9 and below from the back tees (8.1 USGA HCP INDEX) must play the **Green Tees.** USGA course handicaps of 10 & above from the back tees (8.2 USGA HCP INDEX) play from the **White Tees.** Players **50** and over may play the **White Tees,** and Players **65** & over may play the **Gold Tees regardless of handicap.**
- Strokes will be taken as assigned from the appropriate tees, and will be marked on your scorecard.
- Players will have an allowance of **90% of their Course Handicap.**
- **Teams will be flighted** by their combined team handicap.
- Play own ball, down, through the green and hole out.
- If determined to be out of the hole, you may pick up, but partner **MUST** finish the hole.
- Each team will score the Best Ball total on each hole.
- All play will be governed by Summer Rules, or as it lies (Down) except as otherwise provided by the Rules of Golf.
- 14 club and one ball rule apply.
- Putt everything out. **NO GIMMIES!**

Local Rules

- All roads and fences that separate homes from course are out of bounds (do not receive relief).
- If you are **ON you are IN!** Example: If your ball lies ON the Hazard Line, you are IN THE HAZARD.
- When **Out of Bounds** is defined by a white line on the ground, the line itself is OB. A ball is OB when all of it lies out of bounds.
- **Drop areas** are provided on Legends # 11 & 18, Champions #11 & 16, if you go in the water.

Men's Golf Assoc. – Player of the Year Event

Format: Match Play, with teams flighted by combined Team Handicap. Each flight will consist of 6 Teams. Ideally we will have 8 Flights or 48 Teams. Prizes to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place in each flight. **Hole-In-One Contest (Thursday).** Breakfast buffet, and Lunches, Keg on the Course, Friday & Sat. Awards Dinner Saturday Night w/Open Bar. **Long Drive & Closest to the pin** awards Day two.

Each team will play 5 nine hole matches. Three matches will be played on day one, and two matches on the second day. The winners of the flights will be determined by the number of points accumulated in each match. Points will be awarded on the following basis:

- _ point for each hole tied
- 1 point for each hole won
- _ point for a tie of your match
- 1 point for winning your match

“No Kill Rule”- The most points a team may receive is 7 to 3 on day one. On day two all matches will be able to score as many points as possible.

A **winner and runner-up** from each flight will advance to the **Final Shoot-Out**. In the event of a **Tie** to determine which team advances to the Shoot-Out, the #1 tie breaker will be the results of the head-to-head competition. The 2nd tie breaker will be the total number of points earned from the 5th match. Then the total of matches 4 & 5, then 3, 4, & 5 and etc.

“Aces Wild Shootout”

Following is an introduction to this **new** event for the 2007 golf season, the summer-long qualifying for the “Aces Wild” Shootout:

Rules:

7. You must have an established USGA Handicap, with at least three scores entered per month. (April – August) to be eligible.
8. Each time you enter you must play with at least one other Member that will sign and attest to your score.
9. Play the ball down and follow all the USGA Rules of Golf.
10. You must check in and pay to have your round registered by a Golf Pro who will write your handicap on your card and sign it.
11. The attested scorecard must be returned to the Pro-Shop before closing hours that day.
12. You must be a Member in good standing. Ladies and Gentlemen are all encouraged to participate.

Cost:

\$10.00 per 18 hole attempt.

Format:

Each player will compete from the designated tees that he or she is qualified for with their current handicap and age on that date. You may play either the Legends or Champions Course. Your qualifying score will be your “net score”, the total you shoot for the day, minus your full handicap at that time.

The names and scores of the top 18 “net score” qualifiers will be posted at the Club with season long updating on a regular basis.
