Handicap Program 2007

Tennessee Golf Association (TGA)

The Tennessee Golf Association (TGA) Handicap Program begins January 1st and runs through December 31st. The system computes a valid USGA index according to the schedule below. Handicap Members are required to post ALL acceptable scores, including 9 hole scores, for current index ethical accounting and peer review.

Rule 13. Scores/Handicaps

Each Member participating in a member event is required to have an established handicap that is recorded and maintained by the Club. For each round played, every Member is responsible for turning in his or her scores and applying Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) where needed. Scores and handicaps may be reviewed and/or adjusted at any time by the Handicap Chairperson. Any Member who has failed to comply with the Handicapping System may be declared ineligible to compete in a Club Tournament at the discretion of the Golf Operations Committee and/or Tournament Committee and is subject to standard penalty procedures of the Handicapping System.

PLEASE NOTE: The Handicap Chairman, in coordination with the Handicap Committee and Golf Professionals, may adjust the handicap index of those Members who intentionally do not follow this expectation.

Equitable Stroke Control – 18 Hole Handicap

| Course Handicap | Maximum Number on any Hole |
|-----------------|----------------------------|
| 9 or less | Double Bogey |
| 10 through 19 | 7 |
| 20 through 29 | 8 |
| 30 through 39 | 9 |
| 40 or more | 10 |

Equitable Stroke Control – 9 Hole Handicap

| Course Handicap | Maximum Number on any Hole |
|-----------------|----------------------------|
| 4 or less | Double Bogey |
| 5 through 9 | 7 |
| 10 through 14 | 8 |
| 15 through 19 | 9 |
| 20 or more | 10 |
