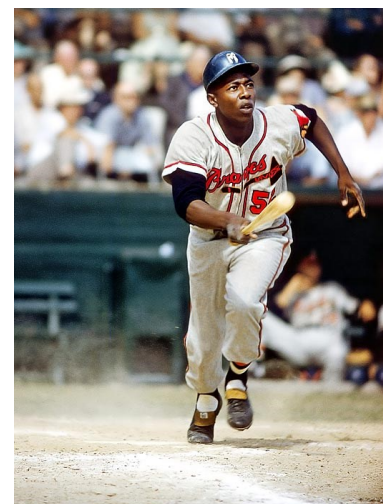
In closing, the MNGC Board of Governors thanks all of you again for your continuing support of MNGC and remember whether a good round or bad, always walk off the course with pride.

Recipe of the Month

Homemade Pimento Cheese

Ingredients

- 2 cups shredded extra-sharp cheddar cheese
- 8 ounces cream cheese
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cayenne pepper (optional)
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and minced
- 1 (4 ounce) jar diced pimento, drained
- Salt and pepper to taste

Directions

Place the Cheddar cheese, cream cheese, mayonnaise, garlic powder, cayenne pepper, onion powder, minced jalapeno, and pimento into a large bowl mixer. Beat at medium speed, with paddle if possible, until thoroughly combined. Season to taste with salt and pepper.

Handicap Rule of the Month

I had a question from a member earlier this month about a ball or pitch mark near the green in the their line of play. I went to the decisions book and this is what I found.

13-2/6 Replacing divot in divot hole on line of play

Q: A player's ball comes to rest close to the putting green and he wishes to use his putter for his next stroke. However there is a divot hole just in front of his ball on his line of play. May the player replace the divot before playing his next stroke?

A: No. Rule 13-2 prohibits a player from improving his line of play by eliminating an irregularity of surface.

The moral of the story is if each player fills his/her own divot with sand or fixes ball marks on the green this will never be a problem. If we leave each hole better than we found it, this will go a long way into making our courses that much better.

Tip of the month-Dan Chartrand

This months lesson isn't about our golf swings or our short game, its about how to properly maintain our golf course. As we can all see there are some amazing improvements being done around the club. We are about to have the best bunkers in town, Casey and his crew will have our course in as good as condition as any in this city. Now comes our part. When you hit your ball in a sand trap make sure you rake your tracks. If someone before you didn't rake theirs, go ahead and take care of it for them. Make sure you fix at least 2 ball marks every hole whether you hit the green or not. We will all be amazed at how our course will look if we did these little things consistently. Fill your divots with sand and continue to try and make your course look better once you have played it than it looked before. The last note is about having courtesy, respect and patience for your fellow members as well. We currently only have one 18 hole course open so some days can become congested on the course. The more we can have respect and patience for one another the smoother and more enjoyable everybody's rounds will be. Your professional staff will be continuing to improve our policies and monitoring to help insure our golf courses pace of play maintains at a smooth and playable pace. We look forward to seeing you all out at the club soon.

Can you believe the weather we are having? The combination of that and the reopening of Champions is making me really excited for our upcoming spring and summer. This will be a year like no other at Memphis National.

Coming up on March 18 is our annual Sonny Love Tournament. This is an ABCD blind draw scramble, which will be post-flighted. The cost is \$55, plus cart fees where applicable, and that includes golf, prizes, giveaways, and the Irish themed lunch. Golf Course News

Champions Course Completion

By now most of you have had the chance to enjoy a round on the Champions course since the improvements have been completed. Hopefully you're enjoying some of the design changes and hitting some good bunker shots. Although the construction is finished, there is still work to do in order to ensure a smooth grow in process between now and early summer. Once growing conditions begin the maintenance staff will begin lowering cuts in areas of need and topdressing sod seams in order to smooth the playing surface as soon as possible. This will be an ongoing process during the first half of the growing season that will require multiple applications of sand and fertility to achieve the desired conditions.

As a member there are several things you can do to help us ensure a speedy and successful grow in as well. Many sodded areas will remain too soft for cart traffic as a result of construction during the winter. Once the soil receives several rain events and is allowed to dry out completely, these areas will start to firm up. Rooting of the sod will also help this process once warmer weather arrives. Until the sod is rooted and the soil has firmed up, the following steps will allow for a speedy and damage free grow in.

All sodded areas located in an area that would normally receive cart traffic will be marked with white flags. Please avoid these areas for now, until the grass is grown in and established enough to receive cart traffic. Once ready, the maintenance staff will begin removing flags and allowing normal cart traffic.



Green and white stakes will be placed at tee and green parking areas where sod has been installed. Many of these damaged areas have occurred over time from pulling carts off the path near tees and greens. Going forward these stakes will be utilized to prevent carts from doing further damage in these areas.



Rakes will be placed on the backside of all bunkers to encourage members to enter and exit at that spot. This will minimize disruption in the bunkers and help keep them consistent. Also, hopefully this discourages everyone from entering and exiting at the steep part of the bunker where sod may not be rooted and established. More sand is displaced when entering this way as well.



Thank you for your help! I hope to see you on the course soon!
